INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE - Please read carefully

General Step by Step Guidelines:

- 1. Secure the horse in cross ties.
- 2. Before treatment, brush dirt away from the head and neck of the horse.
- 3. Pre-warm the TMJ Hood system on the high setting for a few minutes before placing on the horse's head.
- 4. Fasten the TMJ Hood comfortably on the horse using the Velcro Straps.
- 5. Use the high setting for first 10 minutes of therapy.
- 6. After the initial ten minutes, turn the switch to the low setting and maintain this setting until the therapy session is complete.
- 7. Disinfect the inside of the TMJ Hood with a mild disinfectant after use and allow it to dry before storing in a clean place.
- 8. If necessary sponge off the horse's head after treatment.

Important Safety Instructions

- Never use the TMJ Hood along with any type of liniment, salve or ointment.
- Do not put the TMJ Hood on the horse and leave unattended. Check hide under TMJ Hood frequently.
- Do not immerse the TMJ Hood cover in water unless the heat inserts and wiring harness have been removed.
- Do not use pins or other metallic objects to hold the TMJ Hood cover in place.
- Never use the heat inserts without yellow cover in place.
- Periodically examine the heat inserts (PVC). Return the TMJ Hood for repair if the heat inserts show any sign of deterioration.
- Do not fold or bend the heat inserts.
- Do not pull the TMJ Hood by the cord or use the cord as a handle.

TMJ Hood Assembly

Both cords from the TMJ heat inserts are run through this channel and then branch out left and right here



- There are 4 heat inserts in the TMJ Hood System.
- Two heat inserts are positioned along side the TMJ (temporomandibular joint) and two heat inserts along the poll.
- The "hard side" of the heat inserts should be placed inside the TMJ Hood cover so that the hard side is facing towards the horse when the TMJ Hood is in place.
- Each heat insert plugs into the harness which runs along a top spine that branches into two veins to accommodate the heat inserts used for treating the poll area.
